50 I like my family because everyone is different. Some are calm, some are loud, some are funny, and some are brave. But we all belong together, and that makes me happy.

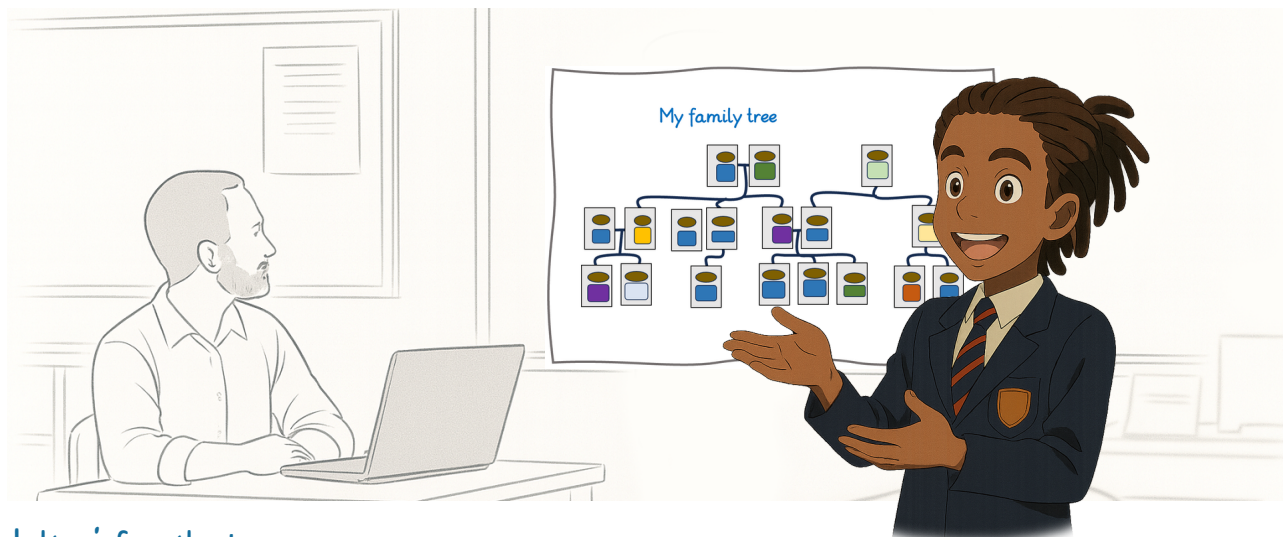
