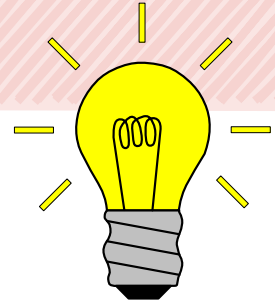

Comperative



Miranda: I am feeling much **better**.

*Comparative adjectives are used to show change or make comparisons. And we use **than** when we want to compare one thing with another.*

Structure:

> Adjectives with one syllable:

— We add **-er**

hard - harder small - smaller

> Adjectives with one syllable ending in **e**:

— We add **-r**.

wide - wider large - larger

> Adjectives ending in a vowel + consonant:

— We double the consonant and add **er**.

fit - fitter big - bigger

> Adjectives ending in a consonant + **-y**:

— We change **-y** to **-i** and add **er**.

happy - happier muddy - muddier

> Most adjectives with two or more syllables:

— We use **more** before the adjective

more beautiful **more** amazing
