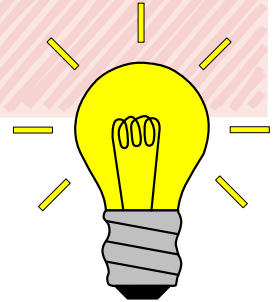

### Grammar section



#### Simple Past



August: I know Mr Tushman **told** you to be friends with me.

*The Simple Past is used to talk about something that happened in the past.*

#### Structure:

> We usually add **-ed** to regular verbs.

to walk - walked  to rain - rained **ed**

> When a verb ends in **-e** we only add **-d** to the verb.

to use -used  to hope - hoped

> When a verb ends in **-y**, we change the **-y** to **-i** and add **-ed**.

to carry - carried  to apply - applied **ed**

> When a verb ends in **-y** AND there is vowel (a, e, i, o, u) before the **-y** then we don't change the **-y**.

to pray - prayed  to enjoy - enjoyed **ed**

> When the verb ends in **-m, -n, -p, -t**, we double these letters and add **-ed**

to stop - stopped  to plan - planned
