Simple Past



August: I know Mr Tushman **told** you to be friends with me.

The Simple Past is used to talk about something that happened in the past.

Structure:

> We usually add **-ed** to regular verbs.

to walk - walk**ed** to rain - rain**ed**

> When a verb ends in **-e** we only add **-d** to the verb.

to use -use**d** to hope - hope**d**

> When a verb ends in -y, we change the -y to -i and add -ed.

to carry - carri**ed** to apply - appli**ed**

> When a verb ends in **-y** AND there is vowel (a, e, i, o, u) before the **-y** then we don't change the **-y**.

to pray - pray**ed** to enjoy - enjoy**ed**

> When the verb ends in **-m**, **-n**, **-p**, **-t**, we double these letters and add **-ed**
