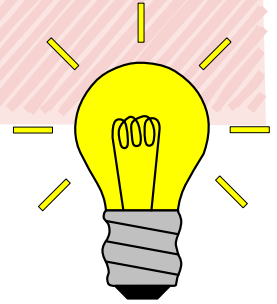

Simple Past Irregular Verbs

💡 Miles: „You **took** the woman I love.“

The Simple Past is used to talk about something that happened in the past.

Structure:

> Most verbs have a past tense and past participle.
We usually add **-ed** to regular verbs.

to walk - **walked**

to rain - **rained**

> But many of the most frequent verbs are irregular:

to take - **took**

to be - **was/were**

to write - **wrote**

to think - **thought**
