Irregular Verbs



Kiles: "You **took** the woman I love."

The Simple Past is used to talk about something that happened in the past.

Structure:

> Most verbs have a past tense and past participle. We usually add **-ed** to <u>regular verbs</u>.

to walk - walked

to rain - rained

> But many of the most frequent verbs are irregular:

to take - took

to be - was/were

to write - wrote

to think - thought
