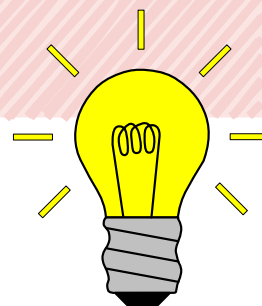




## Chapter 6

#### Adverbs of manner



Tom: „I'm **terribly** bored.“

*Adverbs of manner describe how an action can be done.*

#### Structure:

> We usually add **-ly** to the adjective:

quick - quick**ly**

careful - careful**ly**

> When an adjective ends in **-y** we change the **-y** to **-i** then add **-ly**.

happy - happi**ly**

easy - easi**ly**

> When the adjective ends in **-le**, we change the **-e** to **-y**

horrible - horribl**ly**

breakable - breakabl**ly**

> Also there are some irregular adverbs:

good - well

fast - fast

hard - hard

late - late

straight - straight

early - early

high - high
