#### **Grammar section**

#### Adverbs of manner



Tom: "I'm **terribly** bored."

Adverbs of manner describe how an action can be done.

#### Structure:

> We usually add **-ly** to the adjective:

quick - quick**ly** 

careful - carefully

> When an adjective ends in **-y** we change the **-y** to **-i** then add **-ly**.

happy – happi**ly** 

easy – easi**ly** 

> When the adjective ends in -le, we change the -e to -y

horrible - horrib**ly** 

breakable - breakab**ly** 

> Also there are some irregular adverbs:

good - well

fast - fast

hard – hard

late - late

straight – straight

early - early

high - high
