But **not everyone** thinks it's such a great idea to keep the palace as it is.

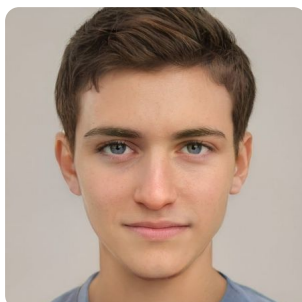
