### Singular (Einzahl)

I <b>was</b>	ich <b>war</b>
you <b>were</b>	du <b>warst</b> / Sie <b>waren</b>
he <b>was</b>	er <b>war</b>
she <b>was</b>	sie <b>war</b>
it <b>was</b>	es <b>war</b>

### Plural (Mehrzahl)

we <b>were</b>	wir <b>waren</b>
you <b>were</b>	ihr <b>wart</b> / Sie <b>waren</b>
they <b>were</b>	sie <b>waren</b>
