





Option 1: Buckingham Palace

Answer these questions in your talk:

- 2 What interesting or historic event happened there?
- 3 Do you think the royal family should still live in Buckingham Palace? Why / why not?

Useful phrases:

Option 2: Present a person from the Commonwealth

Answer these questions in your talk:

- 1 Who is the person and where are they from?
- 2 What did they do or achieve that makes them important?
- 3 Why do you think this person is a good example of the Commonwealth today?

Useful phrases:

This person is from... / He (She) is famous for... / He (She) fought for... / I think he (she) is important because...
